Cases for discussion:

21-13- On 1/4/21, an elderly female was a victim of an internet scam that spanned the last year's duration but recently came to a halt. The victim was contacted and told she was a grand prize winner of Publishers Clearing House, but before she could collect her winnings, she had to pay off the rest of the home mortgage. Following instructions from the scammers, she sent approximately \$100,000 through the mail until being alerted by USPS she may be a victim of a scam. This is noteworthy to remind the public of ongoing and ever-changing, and increasingly creative scams that target everyone with special focus on elderly individuals.

21-69- On 01/18/21, two tenants of an apartment complex became involved in a verbal argument in the parking lot. One of the males pulled a loaded handgun from his waistband, pointed it at the victim's head, and threatened to shoot him. The victim male charged the male with the gun and chased him back into his residence. SPD officers arrived and arrested the suspect and recovered the loaded handgun, which was seized. The suspect was arrested for felony assault with a deadly weapon.
