Cases For discussion:

20-1143- On September 06, 2020, a male victim was walking in the area of downtown Sonora when he was stabbed with an unknown object. The victim, a listed transient, stated he was walking at about 2329 hours when he was approached from behind by an unknown suspect. The victim stated after he was assaulted, the subject took his phone and backpack. The victim went on to say that the subject told him if he looked at him or back at him, he would “stab him in the neck.” The victim was not cooperative with officers and stated he was unable to provide a suspect description. Rumors in the transient circles imply this was a dispute and not a robbery; however, it is difficult to confirm at this point.

20-1120- On September 08, 2020, Jessie Glen Peterson, 30 of Sonora, was arrested for felony arson. On the date of the incident, a witness saw Peterson, a transient, light a piece of wood on fire, then shortly after toss it near a debris pile adjacent to an occupied building. Luckily a good Samaritan stomped out the wood chip before it was able to spread. Due to the current “state of emergency,” a specific charge of arson during a state of emergency was taken against Peterson.
