Case(s) for discussion:

On 12/05/2024 Officers were dispatched to reports of a Domestic Dispute. Prior to the arrival of officers, dispatch informed them reports were coming in of a female screaming as well as hearing loud banging coming from the apartment.

When officers arrived, they contacted a very emotional and distraught female standing outside of the residence. During the investigation and hard work of the officers, they learned the argument had become violent. The male struck the female multiple times in the face, pushed her to the ground, choked her and pinned her down so she could not get away.

The male told the female that he was going to kill her during this physical altercation. Officers were able to obtain an Emergency Protective Order from a Tuolumne County Judge. The male was transported to the Tuolumne County Jail where he was booked for felony domestic battery, felony criminal threats, and felony false imprisonment.

12/22/2024 Officers responded to reports of a theft at a local business. When officers arrived, they met with store employees and got a description of the male. Officers began walking through the business in an attempt to locate the male.

Officers located the male in the business and began escorting him to the Loss Prevention Office. While walking with the male, he began to speed up trying to walk away from officers. The officer's grabbed the males clothing, in an attempt to stop him from walking away.

The male pushed one of the officers in an attempt to get away and run out of the business. This resulted in a physical altercation between the male and the officers, which lasted approximately two minutes. The male was placed under arrest and transported to the Tuolumne County Jail. The male was booked into jail for theft, obstructing and resisting a peace officer, and a felony warrant.
