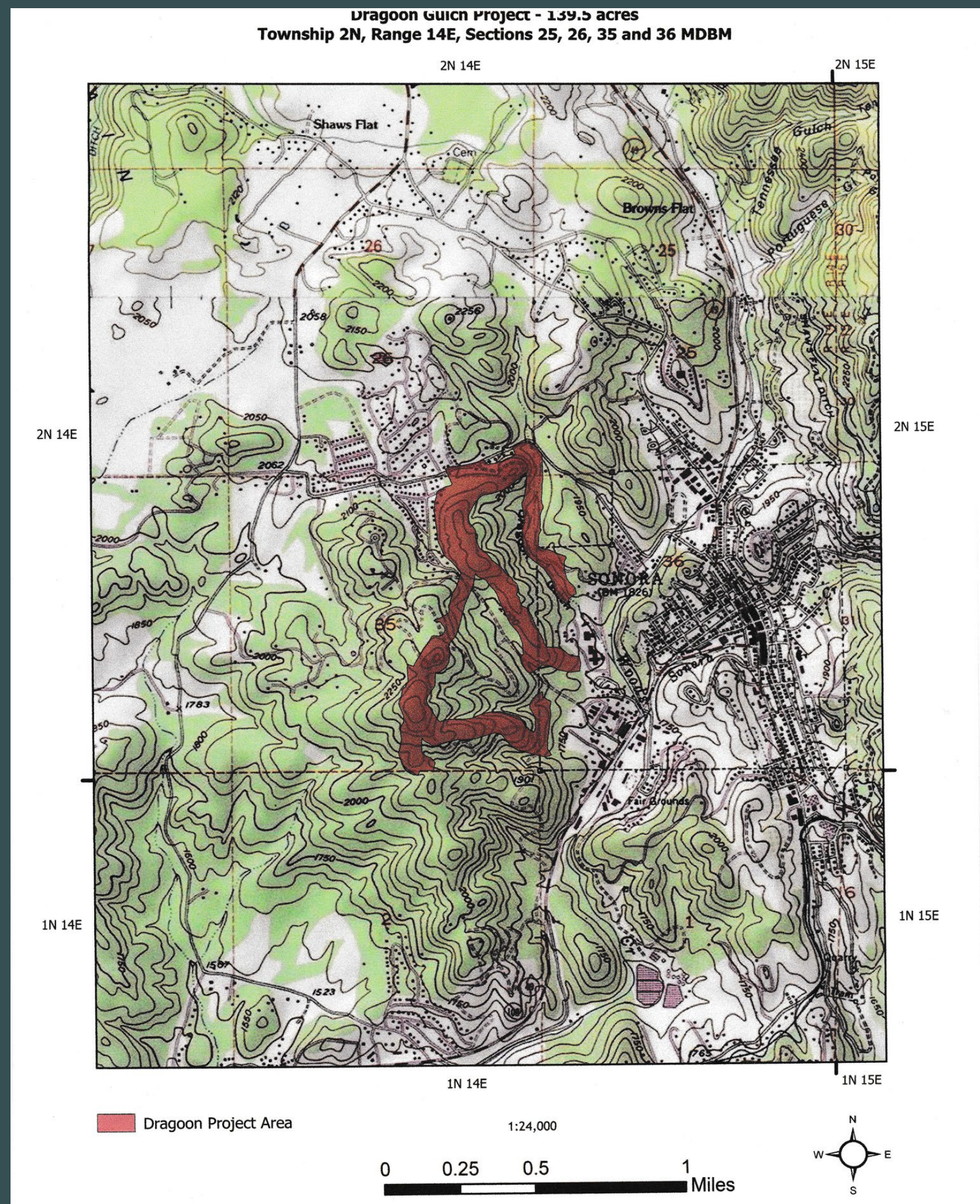


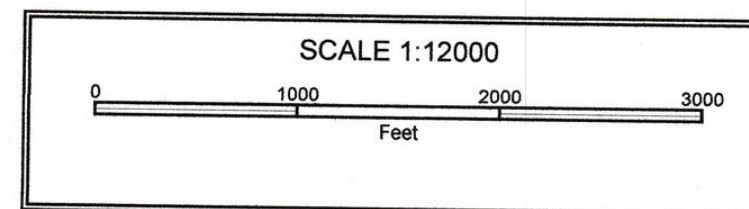
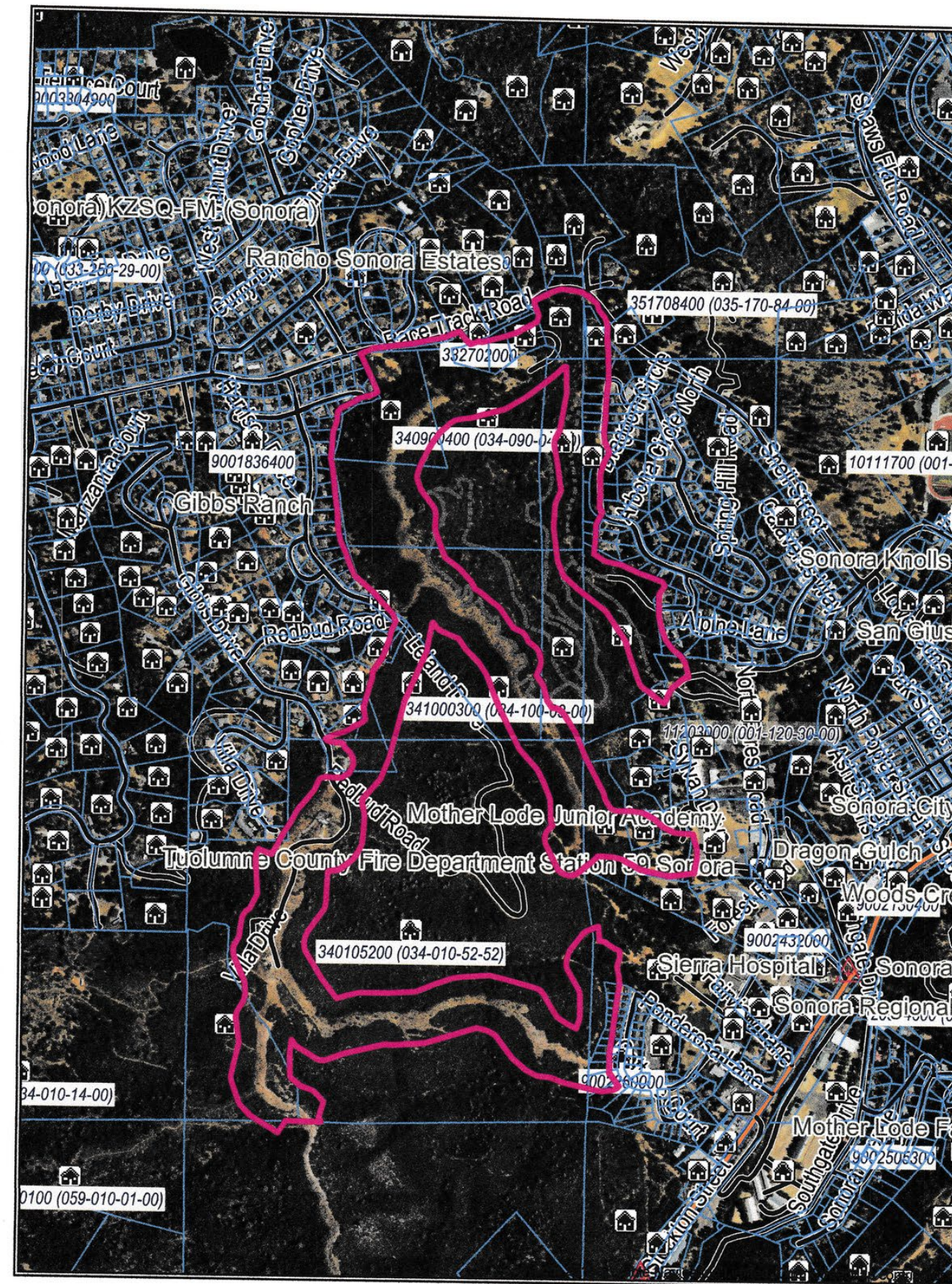

Scope of work

- Masticate brush growing in dozer lines. Retain some oak regeneration in dozer lines
- Masticate or pile and burn wind rows of brush created during fire line construction
- Masticate, chip, or pile and burn approximately 100 feet on either side of the dozer lines and in selected areas to create a shaded fuel break condition. Space trees or clumps of brush 25 feet apart
- Masticate, chip, or pile and burn brush and trees less than 12 inches diameter at breast height to achieve spacing
- Prune residual trees to a height of 8 feet above ground level
