# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHERN SHORES, NORTH CAROLINA

### ARTICLE I. Purpose(s) and Authority.

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 160D-701, the Town of Southern Shores (the "Town") may enact and amend ordinances regulating the zoning and development of land within its jurisdiction. Pursuant to this authority and the additional authority granted by N.C.G.S. § 160D-702, the Town has adopted a comprehensive zoning ordinance (the "Town's Zoning Ordinance") and has codified the same as Chapter 36 of the Town's Code of Ordinances (the "Town Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Town further finds that in accordance with the findings above it is in the interest of and not contrary to the public's health, safety, and general welfare for the Town to amend the Town's Zoning Ordinance as stated below.

### **ARTICLE II. Construction.**

For purposes of this ordinance amendment, underlined words (underline) shall be considered as additions to existing Town Code language and strikethrough words (strikethrough) shall be considered deletions to existing language. Any portions of the adopted Town Code which are not repeated herein, but are instead replaced by an ellipses ("...") shall remain as they currently exist within the Town Code.

### ARTICLE III. Amendment of Subdivision Ordinance and Zoning Ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Town Council of the Town of Southern Shores, North Carolina, that the Town Code shall be amended as follows:

**PART I.** That **Sec. 30-2 Definitions.** Be amended as follows:

Building setback line means the line within a property defining the required minimum distance between any building and the adjacent right-of-way or lot.

9 10 11 12 13 14	Yard means a required open space, other than a court, unoccupied and unobstructed by any structure or portion of a structure, from 30 inches above the ground level of the graded lot upward, provided, however, that eaves, fences, walls, poles, posts, ocean dune platforms, walks, accessible ramps, steps and other customary yard accessories, ornaments, and furniture may be permitted in any yard subject to height limitations and requirements limiting obstruction of visibility or any other requirements of this chapter.				
15 16 17 18 19 20 21	(1) Yard, front. A yard extending between side lot lines across the front of a lot adjoining the public street. Depth of required front yard shall be measured at right angles to a straight line joining the foremost points of the side lot lines. The foremost point of the side lot line, in the case of rounded property corners at street intersections, shall be assumed to be the point at which the side and front lot lines would have met without such rounding. Front and rear yard lines shall be essentially parallel.

Depth of a required rear yard shall be measured in such a manner that the yard established is a strip of the minimum width required by district regulations with its inner edge parallel with the rear lot line.

Width of a required side yard shall be measured in such a manner that the yard established is a strip of the minimum width required by district regulations with its inner edge parallel with the side lot line.
