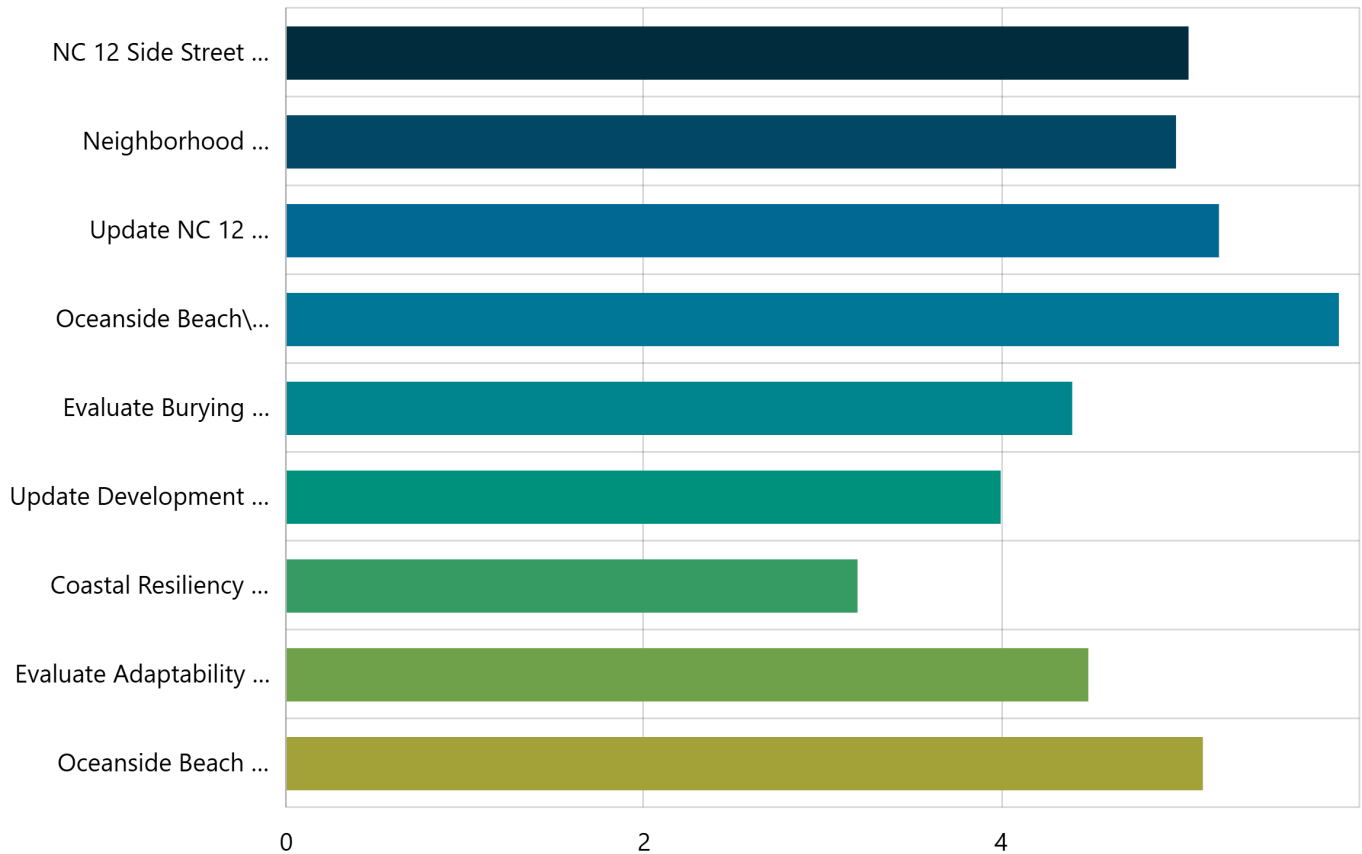

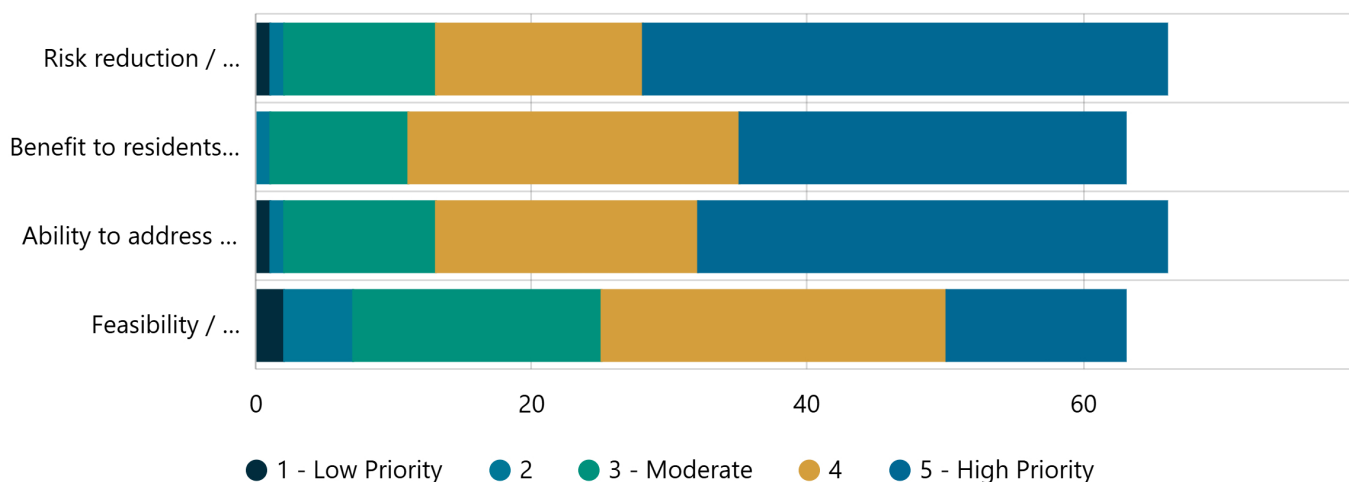
Program
