

## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SALE OF REAL PROPERTY PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. §160A-274 #2023.04.01

**WHEREAS**, North Carolina General Statute §160A-274 authorizes the Town of Southern Shores to sell real property to another governmental unit upon such terms and conditions as it deems wise, with or without consideration; and

**WHEREAS**, The Town of Southern Shores is the owner of a Belgian Malinois Shepherd, K-9 named Echo; and

**WHEREAS**, due to a resignation in the Town's Police Department, K-9 Echo does not presently have a handler; and

**WHEREAS**, The Town has determined that it is not in the best interest of the Town for K-9 Echo to be boarded and inactive while awaiting a new handler to be assigned; and

**WHEREAS**, The Dare County Sheriff's Office administers a K-9 Unit within their Department with a goal to create a safe work environment for law enforcement and to be more efficient in numerous tasks that occur through the use of these specially trained canines and their handlers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Southern Shores desires to sell K-9 Echo to the Dare County Sheriff's Department in support of their Departmental goals; and

**WHEREAS**, the Dare County Sherriff's Office desires to purchase K-9 Echo from the Town of Southern Shores pursuant to the terms of the Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the Town Council of the Town of Southern Shores, hereby agrees to sell K-9 Echo to the Dare County Sheriff's Department for the sum of \$2,500, payable to the Town of Southern Shores; and

The Mayor or her designee are hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents on behalf of the Town in order to convey the Property to the Dare County Sheriff's Office.
