ITEM TITLE: Designation of Voting Delegate for the North Carolina League of Municipalities Board Elections

ITEM SUMMARY: The upcoming election for the North Carolina League of Municipalities (NCLM) leadership relies on a structured, member-driven voting process. To ensure local interests are represented, every member municipality must appoint a single voting delegate to cast their official ballot.

Here is the timeline and procedure for the 2026 election:

- April 13: The Nominating Committee will release the final slate of candidates by 5:00 p.m. At this time, designated delegates will receive their credentials and electronic voting instructions.
- April 13 – April 21: The formal Voting Period is open. During this window, all appointed delegates must submit their votes electronically.
- Verification: Following the close of the polls, the Executive Director will verify the electronic results to ensure accuracy before the annual meeting.
- May 7: The final election results will be officially announced during the Business Meeting at the CityVision Annual Conference.

This process ensures that the Board of Directors—which represents a diverse range of towns from the mountains to the coast—is chosen through a clear, democratic consensus of its member cities.

REQUESTED ACTION: Designate Mayor Morey as the town's voting delegate.
