ORDINANCE NO. 15-2024

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN CITY PROPERTY AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE, DISPOSAL, OR TRANSFER OF SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Council has determined that certain property of the City is no longer

needed by the City for municipal purposes or useful as such, absolutely or temporarily.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Springdale, Ohio, _____ members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. Consistent with Article VIII, Section C(3) of the Charter of the City, and as permitted by Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15, the items listed on the attached Exhibit A owned by the City are hereby declared to be surplus property no longer needed for municipal purposes or useful as such, absolutely or temporarily, and that such property may be sold, by internet auction or otherwise, transferred or disposed of by the City.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to dispose of said property in the manner specified herein.

<u>Section 3.</u> Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this legislation were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4.</u> This ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
