



Police Report

May 2021

The Spring Lake Park Police Department responded to six hundred and twenty-nine calls for service for the month of May 2021. This is compared to responding to six hundred and seventy-one calls for service in May 2020.

Officer Kramer, our School Resource Officer reports handling sixteen calls for service at our local schools for the month of May 2021, along with conducting seventeen student contacts, thirty-one escorts and sixteen follow up investigations into school related incidents. Investigator Bennek reports handling thirteen cases for the month of May 2021. Eleven of these cases were felony in nature, one case was gross misdemeanor in nature and one case was misdemeanor in nature. Investigator Bennek also continues to monitor four forfeiture cases along with his monthly case load, attempting to bring all cases to a conclusion as soon as possible. The Spring Lake Park Police Department Administrative Office Staff continue to remain steadfast in their duties, typing and imaging reports, filing, answering and dispensing phone calls for service and information, along with other duties that may be assigned on a daily basis.

The month of May 2021 has been a busy month for myself as well, besides handling the day to day operations of the police department, I continue to attend meetings on a daily basis representing the City of Spring Lake Park and the Police Department.
