

Police Report

June 2021

The Spring Lake Park Police Department responded to six hundred and fifty calls for service for the month of June 2021. This is compared to responding to six hundred and four calls for service in June 2020.

Investigator Bennek reports handling sixteen cases for the month of June 2021. Fourteen of these cases were felony in nature, one case was gross misdemeanor in nature and one case was misdemeanor in nature. Investigator Bennek also continues to monitor four forfeiture cases along with his monthly case load, attempting to bring all cases to a conclusion as soon as possible. Officer Kramer, our School Resource Officer reports handling six calls for service at our local schools for the month of June 2021, along with conducting seven student contacts, ten escorts and ten follow up investigations into school related incidents. The Spring Lake Park Police Department Administrative Office Staff continue to remain steadfast in their duties, typing and imaging reports, filing, answering and dispensing phone calls for service and information, along with other duties that may be assigned on a daily basis.
