RESOLUTION NO. 2026-21

A RESOLUTION ORDERING IMPROVEMENT AND PREPARATION OF PLANS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2026-17, adopted on April 6, 2026, the city engineer has prepared plans and specifications for the 2026 Street Improvement Project, consisting of improvements to Plaza Boulevard from the right-of-way line at 85th Avenue to its southern terminus approximately 250 feet south of the centerline of Theorin Terrace; Theorin Terrace from the centerline of Plaza Boulevard to the centerline of Center Drive; Center Drive from the right-of-way line at 85th Avenue to the centerline of the Trunk Highway 10 Service Drive; Sunset Road from the right-of-way line at 85th Avenue to the centerline of the Trunk Highway 10 Service Drive; and the Trunk Highway 10 Service Drive from the right-of-way line at Anoka County Highway 10 west approximately 570 feet by rehabilitating said streets, along with any needed sanitary sewer, storm sewer, water system and sidewalk repairs discovered during the project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Spring Lake Park, Minnesota:

1. Such plans and specifications, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby approved.
2. The Administrator, Clerk/Treasurer shall prepare and cause to be inserted in the official paper an advertisement for bids upon the making of such improvement under such approved plans and specifications. The advertisement shall be published for 21 days, shall specify the work to be done, shall state that bids will be received by the Administrator, Clerk/Treasurer until ____am/pm on _____, ____, 2026, at which time they will be publicly opened in the Spring Lake Park City Hall Council Chambers by the Administrator, Clerk/Treasurer and engineer, will then be tabulated and will be considered by the council at 7:00pm on June 15, 2026 in the Council Chambers. Any bidder whose responsibility is questioned during consideration of the bid will be given an opportunity to address the council on the issue of responsibility. No bids will be considered unless sealed and filed with the Administrator, Clerk/Treasurer and accompanied by a cash deposit, cashier's check, bid bond or certified check payable to the Administrator, Clerk/Treasurer for ____% of the amount of such bid.
