MAY 1, 2025**

WHEREAS, Loyalty Day was first observed in 1921 as a special day for the reaffirmation of loyalty to the United States of America and the recognition of the heritage of American freedom; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 1958, Congress enacted Public Law 85-529, which designated May 1 of each year as Loyalty Day, a legal holiday, and a special day for the reaffirmation of loyalty to the United States and for the recognition of the heritage of American freedom; and

WHEREAS, Loyalty Day is an opportunity for all citizens to reflect on the proud history of our nation, the freedoms we cherish, and the responsibilities we share as Americans; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the people of Spring Lake Park observe Loyalty Day with appropriate ceremonies and activities that honor our nation, its flag, and the ideals for which it stands; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Lake Park expresses appreciation to all those who defend our freedoms and uphold the principles of democracy and liberty.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Robert Nelson, Mayor of the City of Spring Lake Park, do hereby proclaim May 1, 2025 as

LOYALTY DAY

in the City of Spring Lake Park and encourage all residents to join in this observance by reaffirming their loyalty to our great nation and the values upon which it was founded.
