Submitted for Council Meeting January 19, 2021

The Spring Lake Park Police Department responded to seven hundred and eleven calls for service for the month of December 2020. This is compared to responding to six hundred and thirty-five calls for service in December 2019.

Our School Resource Officer, Officer Kramer reports handling thirteen calls for service for the month of December at our local schools, along with conducting four student contacts, twenty-three escorts and twenty-nine follow up investigations to school related issues. Investigator Bennek reports handling ten case for the month of December 2020. Eight of these cases are felony in nature and two of these cases are misdemeanor in nature. Investigator Bennek continues to monitor five forfeiture cases, along with his monthly case load and is attempting to bring all these cases to a conclusion as soon as possible. Investigator Bennek did not a case of interest for the month of December, Investigator Bennek was investigation an aggravated robbery case that occurred and with the assistance of the Hennepin County Violent Offenders Task Force, executed a search warrant in Minneapolis and a person of interest was arrested and charged with 1st Degree Robbery . The Spring Lake Park Police Department Administrative Office Staff continue to remain steadfast in their duties, typing and imaging reports, filing, answering and dispensing phone calls for service and information, along with other duties that may be assigned on a daily basis. The police department administrative staff also continue on a daily basis to address the ongoing concerns of COVID-19 by providing daily sanitary cleaning within our department.

The month of December has been a busy month for myself as well, besides handling the day to day operations of the police department, I continue to attend meetings in person and virtually on a daily basis, representing the City of Spring Lake Park and the Police Department.
