Subject: Cancel Bond Levies

State Law requires the County Auditor to levy the amount of debt service originally certified unless the City passes a resolution cancelling the levy. Resolution 2024-49 would cancel two debt service levies and reduce a third due to the City having funds on-hand to make the debt service payment.

The following debt service levies would be reduced by the proposed resolution:

<u>Issue</u>	<u>Original</u>	Proposed
2016A GO Capital Note (NMTV cable upgrade)	\$ 13,263.26	\$ 0.00
2021A GO Improvement Refunding Bond (streets)	\$265,214.72	\$ 0.00
2024A GO Capital Improvement Plan Bond (City Hall)	\$604,747.50	\$444,747.00

The following bonds are reduced due to a combination of Public Utilities funds, Special Assessments, Cable PEG Fees, Municipal State Aid funds, and General Fund budget allocations.
