

# Police Report July 2022 Submitted for Council Meeting: August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022

The Spring Lake Park Police Department responded to eight hundred and four calls for service for the month of July 2022. This is compared to responding to six hundred and eighty-eight calls for service in July 2021.

Investigator Bennek reports handling twenty-eight cases for the month of July 2022. Twenty-six of these cases were felonies and two were misdemeanors. Investigator Bennek also continues to monitor five forfeiture cases along with his monthly case load. For further details, see Investigator Bennek's attached report.

The Spring Lake Park Police Department Administrative Office Staff continue to do an outstanding job supporting myself and the officers on a daily basis. They are a vital part of our police department and we are thankful for them.

The month of July 2022 has been a busy month for myself. Besides handling the day to day operations of the police department, I continue to attend meetings on a daily basis representing the City of Spring Lake Park and the Police Department. I continued to run the officer hiring process as well and am looking forward to wrapping that up in the future.
