The Spring Lake Park Police Department responded to seven-hundred sixty-five calls for service for the month of June 2026. This is compared to responding to seven-hundred eighty-three calls for service in June 2025.

Detective Imig reports working twelve new cases for the month of June 2026. Twelve of those cases were felony and two were gross misdemeanor case. Detective Imig also continues to monitor five forfeiture cases. Detective Imig reported working several auto theft task force details in the month of June 202.
