Subject: Resolution of Support - Anoka County JLEC

The City of Spring Lake Park is a member of the Anoka County Joint Law Enforcement Council (JLEC), which was formed nearly 50 years ago to benefit the public safety for the citizens of Anoka County. The JLEC received special legislative authority in 2011 to levy a county-wide tax to fund the County's Public Safety Data System. This levy expires in 2023.

The JLEC is seeking to renew the special legislative authority through 2023 to fund county-wide public safety improvements/equipment. As was done in 2011, the JLEC is seeking resolutions of support for this legislation. Staff has prepared a resolution of support for possible City Council adoption.

The resolution does not obligate the City in any way. Rather, it is a statement of support for the extension of the existing public safety levy.

JLEC members Mayor Nelson and Chief Antoine can provide additional details regarding the discussions associated with this request.
