**A RESOLUTION APPROVING SUMMARY PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCE NO. 510,
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTERS 7.04 AND 7.08 OF THE SPRING LAKE
PARK CITY CODE RELATING TO TRAFFIC AND PARKING REGULATIONS**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Spring Lake Park has adopted Ordinance No. 510, entitled “An Ordinance Amending Chapters 7.04 and 7.08 of the Spring Lake Park City Code Relating to Traffic and Parking Regulations”; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, section 412.191, subdivision 4, authorizes the City Council, by a four-fifths vote of its members, to direct publication of only the title and a summary of a lengthy ordinance when the summary clearly informs the public of the ordinance’s intent and effect; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the summary of Ordinance No. 510 set forth below and determines that it clearly informs the public of the intent and effect of the ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Spring Lake Park, Minnesota that the following summary of Ordinance No. 510 is approved for publication:

“On August 3, 2026, the Spring Lake Park City Council adopted Ordinance No. 510, amending Chapters 7.04 and 7.08 of the Spring Lake Park City Code relating to traffic and parking regulations. The ordinance updates definitions and regulations governing off-road vehicles, snowmobiles, bicycles, electric-assisted bicycles, electric scooters, electric personal assistive mobility devices, and other motorized devices; revises seasonal road restrictions and median-safety requirements; and clarifies general traffic-safety standards. The ordinance also updates parking regulations concerning the 24-hour street-parking limit, large trucks and commercial vehicles, trailers and recreational vehicles, driveway and mailbox access, winter and snow-emergency restrictions, vehicle removal and towing, administrative citations, registered-owner responsibility, and parking-enforcement officers.
