PROJECT TITLE: Floating Feather to Star Middle School Pathway

Separate sealed Bids for the Floating Feather to Star Middle School Pathway will be received by the City of Star, Idaho *10769 West State Street, Star, ID 83669*, until **4:00 pm local time on *October 11, 2023***, and then publicly opened and read aloud shortly thereafter in the Council Chambers at City Hall, *10769 West State Street, Star, ID 83669*.

The project consists of the construction of a 7-ft wide concrete sidewalk along Floating Feather Rd and a 10-ft wide concrete sidewalk from Floating Feather north to the Star Middle School.

All official notifications, addenda, and other Bidding Documents will be offered only through the designated website. Owner will not be responsible for addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the designated website.

A pre-bid conference will be held at **1:30 p.m.** local time on **October 3, 2023**, on site. We will meet in the parking lot of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints meeting house at 9400 W Floating Feather Rd, Star, ID 83669. We will gather at the southwestern corner of the parking lot. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is strongly encouraged but is not mandatory.

In determining the lowest responsive bid, the Owner will consider all acceptable bids on a basis consistent with the bid package. The Owner will also consider whether the bidder is a responsible bidder.

All bids must be signed and accompanied by evidence of authority to sign.

Bids must be accompanied by Bid Security in the form of a bid bond, certified check, cashiers check or cash in the amount of **5%** of the amount of the bid proposal. Said bid security shall be forfeited to Owner as liquidated damages should the successful bidder fail to enter into contract in accordance with their proposal as specified in the Instructions to Bidders.

Owner reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, waive any nonmaterial irregularities in the bids received, and to accept the proposal deemed most advantageous to the best interest of the Owner.
