Justin May suggested ordering 500 lunches this year. We had only 250 last year and ran out quickly. Dana will coordinate with Senior Center on Pie Auction, Lions on Pie-A-Lion, and Anthony Mendoza, our auctioneer.

Dana spoke with Rebecca Gordon before the meeting. Rebecca has already ordered the kids water games for the event. She has added additional slip and slide events.

Chief Victor would like to rethink how the food trucks are placed this year. He would like pre-approval of the placement map before the event.

A discussion was had on the sound issues over the past two years. Since we opened the west baseball field, people in that area cannot see the stage or hear the music. People along the back berm also had trouble hearing. The Mayor would like to see an improvement. Larry Osborn suggested calling Amplified Production Group. Dana will call and get an estimate for next meeting.

Mayor said the fireworks show would be bigger this year. The U.S. sparkler flag fell a bit flat. That money would be put into additional aerals this year. Dana noted that community feedback asked for more patriotic music during the show.
