LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

The Looking to the Future plan renews an expanded community gathering place where the courthouse town now exists, creating a place that welcomes locals - as well as visitors - and provides a focal area for activities supporting civic and business interests in the heart of Downtown Stevenson. Plan highlights include:

- ADA pathway from the sidewalk allows access to stage, upper plaza & Courthouse
- Monumental corten column art acts as beacon for the plaza & downtown
- Staircase with circular landings overlook a natural creek waterfall feature
- Street level, ADA restrooms built into hillside
- Roof-top terrace above restrooms with views of the flush fountain & plaza below
- Locations for public art at top of terrace & pathway round-about
- Elevated stage area with terraced seating and community Christmas tree
- Flush fountain, fire pits, built in benches, historical signing, indigenous landscaping
- Shaded outdoor dining area, movable tables and chairs throughout
