To the City Council,

While I was on work-related travel in Japan from September 6–13, 2025, a failure occurred in the water line to my home near the shutoff valve. My pet sitter discovered standing water in the yard surrounding the shutoff access point. On September 11, PUD was contacted to shut off water service to my home.

Due to limited availability, a plumber was not able to assess the issue until September 17. At that time, the leak was located on my property side of the shutoff valve (see attached invoice for repair details). The necessary repairs were completed, water service was restored, and photos of the repair are attached for reference.

As a result of this leak, the City recorded 11,924 cubic feet of water usage during this period—significantly exceeding my normal consumption since I purchased the home in 2020. Because this excessive usage was directly caused by the leak, which I addressed as quickly as possible once discovered, I respectfully request that the City Council approve an adjustment to my water bill to account for the water loss associated with this event.
