Subject: Request for Approval of Water Service Connection Outside City Limits

Dear Mayor and Members of the Stevenson City Council:

We recently purchased a residential property located at 6032 E Loop Road, approximately 300 yards outside of the City of Stevenson. We intend to use the home, built in 1924, as a long-term rental. We are requesting the City Council consider approving a residential water connection to this home.

- The property is contiguous to an existing city water main. We have attached a map indicating the location of our current residential connection, which is located across Loop Rd, and the location of the requested new connection.
- New water service to this property would require only a service connection to the existing water main and a meter. No expansion of the water main is required.
- Currently 6032 E Loop Road has no source of potable water. The residence relies on surface water from Nelson Creek which is unsafe for domestic use and is subject to seasonal shortages, leaving the property without a reliable source of water for much of the year. Well water in this area is unreliable.
- It is our understanding the City of Stevenson has capacity for additional residential water connections.
- We are prepared to assume financial responsibility for this project including connection to the water main, meter installation, permits, and applicable city fees. We will also grant or obtain the necessary utility easements and install any necessary backflow-prevention devices.
