AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING CHAPTER 7 RIGHT-OF-WAY/TRAFFIC/PARKING/STREETS IN THE CITY CODE – 2ND READING

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. FRANCIS, ANOKA COUNTY, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Changes in the following sections are denoted with an <u>underline for new text</u> or a strikethrough for deleted language. Renumbering and updated references shall occur throughout the Code as needed when subsections are added or deleted.

<u>Section 1.</u> Section 7-4-5 On-Street Recreational Vehicle Parking of the St. Francis Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

It is unlawful for any person to leave or park a recreational camping vehicle, utility trailer, or boat (as defined in Section 10-16-5.D<u>10-23-16</u>) on or within the limits of any street or right-of-way for a continuous period in excess of twenty-four (24) hours. Provided, however, that during such twenty-four (24) hour period, such vehicle shall not be occupied as living quarters.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage and publication according to law.
