AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CHARTER RELATING TO SECTION 2.05
“VACANCIES IN OFFICE”

THE CITY OF ST. FRANCIS ORDAINS:

Section 1. Charter Revised. That Chapter 2, Section 2.05, of the St. Francis City Charter be amended as follows:

Section 2.05. Vacancies in Office. A vacancy in office on the Council shall be deemed to exist in the case of the failure of any person elected or appointed to the Council to qualify on or before the date of the second regular meeting of the Council following the person’s election or appointment, or by reason of the death, resignation, removal from office, removal from the City, continuous absence from the City or from Council meetings for more than (3) months unless excused by the Council, being adjudged incompetent by a Court of appropriate jurisdiction, or conviction of a felony of any such person after his qualification. In such case the Council shall by resolution declare the vacancy to exist shall post and publish notice of vacancy and after ~~thirty~~ ~~(30)~~ fourteen (14) calendar days, appoint an eligible person to fill the vacancy until the next Municipal election.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect 90 days after its publication.
