Economic Development Authority Annual Report for 2024

The City of St. Francis created an Economic Development Authority (SFEDA) for the purpose of encouraging, attracting and promoting development that would support an economically sound industry and commerce for the City. Council established the SFEDA in 2008.

Meetings:

The Economic Development Authority held one meeting in 2024. Meetings and agenda for each meeting were as follows:

 Items discussed included a Letter of Intent with North Shore Development regarding the construction of a multi-family unit housing building on the EDA owned property at 3731 Bridge Street.

- 3757 and 3765 Bridge Street no current development discussions, parcels are dependent on road completion to the north happening 2025 by Public Works
- 3518 Bridge no current development partners

Projects:
