ACCREDITATION ROAD MAP






ACCREDITATION BENEFITS

- Established agency-wide culture of continuous improvement
- Improved operational performance
- Team building and staff development
- Succession planning/institutional knowledge retention
- Central location for documentation and SOPs
- Increased efficiencies/reduced duplication and wasted resources
- Justification for budget requests
- Lowering of insurance premiums
- Reduced City liability

- There are more than 33,250 counties
 & municipalities in the US.
 - Currently, ONLY 175 Public
 Works agencies are accredited.



CURRENT STATUS OF ACCREDITED PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENTS IN OREGON




