RESOLUTION NO. 2000

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF ST. HELENS THE QUESTION OF ADOPTION OF A 5-YEAR LOCAL OPTION LEVY NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF \$0.52 PER \$1,000 OF ASSESSED PROPERTY VALUE FOR POLICE PROTECTION SERVICES STAFFING BEGINNING FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of St. Helens, Columbia County, Oregon, (the "City") hereby determines that the City should submit to its voters the question of authorizing the City to levy local option taxes of \$0.52 Per \$1,000 of assessed property value each year for five years, beginning in fiscal year 2024-2025 to provide funds for police protection services staffing, and an estimated five-year total of \$3,273,686 would be levied, i.e., \$604,411 for the first year, \$628,587 for the second year, \$653,731 in the third year, \$679,881 in the fourth year, and \$707,076 in the fifth year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY THAT:

Section 1. A measure election is hereby called for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City the question of authorizing the local option levy described in the attached Exhibit A.

Section 2. The measure election hereby called shall be held in the City at the May 2024 election, in accordance with the Oregon Law.

Section 3. The Common Council hereby authorizes the City Recorder to submit a notice of measure election (Exhibit B) and explanatory statement (Exhibit C) to the Elections Officer of Columbia County, Oregon.

Section 4. The City Administrator and City Recorder are authorized and directed to execute all documents, and publish all notices required by law to carry out the intent of this resolution.
