

**AMENDMENT 1 TO  
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
COLUMBIA COUNTY AND THE CITY OF ST. HELENS**

This Amendment 1 is to the Intergovernmental Agreement Columbia County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon (hereinafter the "County"), and the City of St. Helens, a municipality (hereinafter the "City"), dated February 2, 2022 (the "Original Contract").

**RECITALS:**

WHEREAS, the County and the City are authorized under ORS 190.003 to 190.030 and ORS 221.410 to enter into intergovernmental agreements for the performance of any and all functions that the County and the City have authority to perform; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority the parties entered into the Original Contract on February 2, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the cost to construct the improvements that are the subject of the Original Contract have exceeded the amount anticipated at that time.

NOW, THEREFORE, It is hereby agreed as follows:

1. Section 4, subsection e of the Original Contract is amended to read as follows:
  - e. Provide reimbursement to City for costs associated with the project including the replacement of the culvert at Columbia Boulevard and Gable Road. This reimbursement includes \$45,000 in Preliminary and Final Engineering Costs, \$165,000 in Construction Costs and \$210,000 for other costs.
