## DUI Arrest

In December 2021, St. Helens Officer McKenzie McClure successfully completed a DWI (Driving While Impaired) Detection and Standardized Field Sobriety Testing (SFST) Instructor Development Course to become a certified instructor for the St. Helens Police Department.

Officer McClure provides instruction to St. Helen's officers and CC LE Agencies in required DWI detection and proper SFST training and recertification

# Detectives

## Detective Investigations Data

- In 2021, the St. Helens Police Department Investigations Unit completed a total of 522 reports.
- In 2022, the St. Helens Police Department Investigations Unit completed a total of 746 reports. **(A 43% increase)**
- Thus far in 2023: 104 Reports completed; **133 Child Abuse Referrals followed up on in 3 months.**

## Detective Investigations Data

- 2022 12 SHSD Threat Assessments Completed
- Thus far in 2023: 5 SHSD Threat Assessments Completed
- 2022 Executed 51 Search Warrants (**An increase of 25% from 2021**)
- Thus far in 2023: 20 Executed Search Warrants
