**RESOLUTION APPROVING ORDINANCE 038, 4TH SERIES REZONING
PROPERTY FROM B-2, SERVICE BUSINESS DISTRICT, TO I-2, GENERAL
INDUSTRIAL**

WHEREAS, the City of St. James introduced the proposed Ordinance 038, 4th Series rezoning property from B-2, Service Business District, to I-2, General Industrial; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. James City Council reviewed this item during their July 21, 2026, city council meeting, agreed with the recommendation and approved the first reading of the proposed Ordinance 038, 4th Series; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. James City Council held a second reading of the proposed Ordinance 038, 4th Series during their August 5, 2026, meeting; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, Section 412.91, Subd. 4, allows publication by title and summary in the case of lengthy ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. James City Council finds that the following title and summary would clearly inform the public of the intent and effect of the Ordinance 038, 4th Series.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. JAMES, MINNESOTA, that the City of St. James City Council hereby approved the second and final reading of the proposed Ordinance 038, 4th Series rezoning property from B-2, Service Business District, to I-2, General Industrial.
