PURPOSE: The purpose of this agenda item is to approve the Georgia Power Electric Transportation Make Ready Program Customer Proposal Acceptance Letter, which will allow Georgia Power to provide funding assistance and invest in the charging system infrastructure at the City's designated site under the Make Ready Program, as authorized by the Georgia Public Service Commission. Approval of this letter will: Confirm the City's participation in the Make Ready Program, subject to available funding. Allow Georgia Power to own and maintain the charging infrastructure. Require the City, through its agreement with EnviroSpark Networks, LLC, to purchase, install, operate, and maintain the EV chargers at its cost. Authorize execution of related agreements, including the EnviroSpark EV Charging Stations Installation and Services Agreement, which governs installation, service, and ongoing operation of the City-owned chargers. Together, these approvals will enable the City of Stonecrest to move forward with the installation of public-facing EV charging stations, supporting expanded access to electric vehicle infrastructure in alignment with the City's sustainability and transportation goals.



## CITY COUNCIL AGENDA ITEM

FACTS: The City of Stonecrest applied to Georgia Power's Electric Transportation Make Ready Program, established by the Georgia Public Service Commission (Docket #44280). Georgia Power has accepted the City's application, subject to program funding availability. Under the Make Ready Program: Georgia Power will invest in, own, and maintain the charging infrastructure at the approved site. The City must purchase, install, own, and operate the EV chargers at its cost. Georgia Power's support does not cover the purchase or installation of chargers. To fulfill this requirement, staff have negotiated an EV Charging Stations Installation and Services Agreement with EnviroSpark Networks, LLC. The EnviroSpark Agreement provides for: Installation of EV charging equipment at the designated City site. Maintenance and operational services during the contract term. Provisions addressing access, indemnification, insurance, and compliance with applicable laws. Both approvals are necessary to move forward: Approval of the Georgia Power Make Ready Program Acceptance Letter to secure Georgia Power's funding and infrastructure investment. Approval of the EnviroSpark Networks, LLC Installation and Services Agreement to ensure proper installation, operation, and maintenance of the City's EV chargers. Upon Council approval, Georgia Power will confirm funding availability and schedule a pre-construction meeting, and EnviroSpark will coordinate charger installation.
