AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STONECREST, 1 **GEORGIA TO APPROVE SPECIAL LAND USE PERMIT 23-004 ON PARCEL NUMBER** 2 16 084 03 023 TO ALLOW THE OPERATION OF A SHORT-TERM VACATION 3 **RENTAL AT 3575 TRINITY PLACE STONECREST; TO PROVIDE SEVERABILITY;** 4 TO PROVIDE FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE FOR 5 AN ADOPTION AND EFFECTIVE DATE; AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER LAWFUL 6 7 **PUPOSES.** WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Stonecrest ("City") is the Mayor and City 8 9 Council ("City Council") thereof; and 10 WHEREAS, Article IX, Section II, Paragraph IV of the 1983 Constitution of the State of Georgia authorizes the City to adopt plans and exercise the power of zoning; and 11 WHEREAS, the City Council is authorized by O.C.G.A. § 36-35-3 to adopt ordinances 12 relating to its property, affairs, and local government; and 13 WHEREAS, the City of Stonecrest has been vested with substantial powers, rights, and 14 functions to generally regulate the use of real property to maintain health, morals, safety, security, 15 peace, and the general welfare of the City; and 16 WHEREAS, the City received an application for the approval of the operation of a short-17 18 term vacation rental at 3575 Trinity Place Stonecrest; and

19	WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Zoning Ordinance applicants who desire to operate a	
20	short-term vacation rental must obtain a special land use permit; and	
21	WHEREAS, the matter was heard in the City's Community Planning Information Meeting	
22	pursuant to the provisions of the City's Zoning Procedures Law; and	
23	WHEREAS, the City has properly advertised and held a public hearing before the	
24	Planning Commission regarding SLUP 23-004, the request for special land use permit to operate	
25	a short-term vacation rental at 3575 Trinity Place; and	
26	WHEREAS, the City has properly advertised and held a public hearing pursuant to the	
27	provisions of Georgia's Zoning Procedures Law before the City Council prior to the adoption of	
28	this Ordinance; and	
29	WHEREAS, the Director of Planning and Zoning recommends approval of special land	
30	use permit 23-004 of property located at 3575 Trinity Place; and	
31	WHEREAS, the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City will be positively	
32	impacted by the adoption of this Ordinance.	
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35 36	Section 1. SLUP 23-004, the operation of a SHORT-TERM VACATION RENTAL at	
37	3575 Trinity Place Stonecrest, satisfying Section 4.2.58 (Short Term Vacation Rental (STVR) in	
38	Chapter 27 of the City of Stonecrest Code of Ordinances, is APPROVED WITH CONDITIONS	
39	as follows:	
40	1. No city permit for the operation of the short-term vacation rental shall be transferable	
41	will only be permitted for the owner/operator Jeffrey Dickerson;	
42 43	2. Applicant must comply and remain in compliance with <u>ARTICLE VII NOISE</u> <u>ORDINANCE;</u>	
44	3. Short-term rental units must be properly maintained and regularly inspected by the owner	

45 46 or agent to ensure continued compliance with applicable property maintenance, zoning, building, health, and life safety code provisions.

4. All marketing and/or advertising for short-term rental units must contain information 47 concerning the occupancy limit of the short-term rental unit, and the maximum parking 48 available on the property. Advertising for more than the allowable occupancy or allowable 49 parking is prima facie evidence of a violation of the city code. Further, failure to include 50 such occupancy limits and maximum parking availability is prima facie evidence of a 51 violation of the city code. 52

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5. Each Short Term Vacation Rental (STVR) must obtain a city license as well as all license(s) and/or permit(s) required by the State of Georgia before beginning to operate. 54 Section 2. (a) It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that all 55

sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are or were, upon their 56 57 enactment, believed by the Mayor and Council to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional. 58 (b) It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that, to the greatest extent 59 60 allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is 61 62 severable from every other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance. It is 63 hereby further declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that, to the greatest extent 64 65 allowed by law, no section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is mutually 66 67 dependent upon any other section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance. 68 69 (c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall, for 70 any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional, or otherwise unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the express intent of the 71 72 Mayor and Council that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any 73 of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or section of the Ordinance and that, to 74 75 the greatest extent allowed by law, all remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and 76

77 78 79	sections of the Ordinance shall remain valid, constitutional, enforceable, and of full force and	
80	effect.	
81 82	Section 3. The City Clerk, with the concurrence of the City Attorney, is authorized to	
83	correct any scrivener's errors found in this Ordinance, including its exhibits, as enacted.	
84	Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby	
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86	expressly repealed.	
87 88 89	Section 5. The Ordinance shall be codified in a manner consistent with the laws of the	
90	State of Georgia and the City of Stonecrest.	
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92 93	Section 6. It is the intention of the governing body, and it is hereby ordained that the	
94 95	provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made part of the Code of Ordinances, City	
96	Stonecrest, Georgia.
