8	WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Stonecrest ("City") is the Mayor and C	ity
9	Council ("City Council") thereof; and	
10	WHEREAS, Article IX, Section II, Paragraph IV of the 1983 Constitution of the State	of
11	Georgia authorizes the City to adopt plans and exercise the power of zoning; and	
12	WHEREAS, the City Council is authorized by O.C.G.A. § 36-35-3 to adopt ordinance	ces
13	relating to its property, affairs, and local government; and	
14	WHEREAS, the City of Stonecrest has been vested with substantial powers, rights, and	d
15	functions to generally regulate the use of real property to maintain health, morals, safety, securi	ty,
16	peace, and the general welfare of the City; and	
17	WHEREAS, the city received an application for the approval to develop a place of worsh	nip
18	at 3309 and 3313 Panola Road; and	

WHEREAS, pursuant to the city's zoning Ordinance applicants who desire to develop a
place of worship must obtain a special land use permit; and
WHEREAS, the matter was heard in the City's Community Planning Information Meeting
pursuant to the provisions of the City's Zoning Procedures Law; and
WHEREAS, the City has properly advertised and held a public hearing before the
Planning Commission regarding SLUP 23-009, the request for special land use permit to develop
a place of worship at 3309 and 3313 Panola Road; and
WHEREAS, the City has properly advertised and held a public hearing pursuant to the
provisions of Georgia's Zoning Procedures Law before the City Council prior to the adoption of
this Ordinance; and
WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Department recommends denial of special land use
permit 23-009 of property located at 3309 and 3313 Panola Road; and
WHEREAS, the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City will be positively
impacted by the adoption of this Ordinance.
BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF STONECREST, GEORGIA, as follows:
Section 1. SLUP 23-009, to develop a place of worship at 3309 and 3313 Panola Road,
satisfying Section 7.4.6 of Division 4 of Article 7 and Section 4.2.42 of Division 2 of Article 7 in
Chapter 27 of the City of Stonecrest Code of Ordinances, is
Section 2. (a) It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that all
sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are or were, upon their
enactment, believed by the Mayor and Council to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional.
(b) It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that, to the greatest extent

allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance
is severable from every other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance. It
is hereby further declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that, to the greatest extent
allowed by law, no section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is mutually
dependent upon any other section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance.
(c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall, for
any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional, or otherwise unenforceable by the
valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the express intent of the
Mayor and Council that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or unenforceability shall, to the
greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any
of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or section of the Ordinance and that, to
the greatest extent allowed by law, all remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and
sections of the Ordinance shall remain valid, constitutional, enforceable, and of full force and
effect.

- <u>Section 3.</u> The City Clerk, with the concurrence of the City Attorney, is authorized to correct any scrivener's errors found in this Ordinance, including its exhibits, as enacted.
- <u>Section 4.</u> All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.
- <u>Section 5.</u> The Ordinance shall be codified in a manner consistent with the laws of the State of Georgia and the City of Stonecrest.
 - <u>Section 6.</u> It is the intention of the governing body, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made part of the Code of Ordinances, City of Stonecrest, Georgia.
