Agenda Item Description (Background/History/Details):

The Stone Mountain Livable Centers Initiative (LCI) Study establishes a vision and implementation framework to create a more connected, vibrant, and equitable Stone Mountain. Funded through the Atlanta Regional Commission, the study builds on the City's Comprehensive Plan and previous LCI and PATH initiatives by focusing on walkability, multimodal connectivity, public spaces, economic development, housing, and revitalization of Downtown Stone Mountain.

The planning process included input from residents, businesses, artists, and community stakeholders and identifies priority projects and strategies for phased implementation.
