Workplan Goal Details:

Governance: Promote ethical governance, accountability, openness, and public confidence by ensuring the City's Ethics Board is fully constituted and able to perform its duties in accordance with City Code and established ethical standards.

Agenda Item Description (Background/History/Details):

Sec. 2-158 - There is created the board of ethics of the city to be composed of eight (8) residents of the city to be appointed as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection. Each member of the board of ethics shall have been a resident of the city for at least one (1) year immediately preceding the date of taking office and shall remain a resident of the city while serving as a member of the board of ethics. No person shall serve as a member of the board of ethics if the person has, or has had within the immediately preceding two-year period, any interest in any contract, transaction, or official action of the city.

If a member of the board of ethics ceases to be a resident of the city, that members' position on the board, by operation of law, shall become vacant. A vacancy in the board of ethics shall exist by reason of death, resignation, or loss of residency.

There are currently (2) vacancies to the Ethics Board that must be filled. Both are the Mayor's appointees.
