**ORDINANCE 2026-13**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STONE MOUNTAIN, GEORGIA, OFFICIALLY SETTING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING 2026-2027 PROPERTY TAX MILLAGE RATE AT 17.500 MILLS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Stone Mountain is required by O.C.G.A. § 48-5-32.1 to adopt a millage rate after satisfying the advertising and public hearing requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Stone Mountain has met the advertisement and public hearing requirements set forth in O.C.G.A. § 48- 5-32.1; and

**WHEREAS**, the property tax bills can only be issued after the millage rate has been set;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STONE MOUNTAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1. Adoption of Millage Rate.** The Mayor and Council hereby adopt the Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Millage Rate in the amount of 17.500 mills ad valorem taxes.

**Section 2. Filing Copies of this Ordinance.** The City Manager is authorized and directed to file a copy of this Ordinance in the Office of the City Clerk where it shall be certified and made available for public inspection.

**Section 3. Severability.** If any section, part, or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this ordinance, and all parts, sections, whereas clauses, and other provisions of this ordinance shall be severable.

**Section 4. Effective date.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. Resolved this 16th day of June, 2026.
