<b>Agenda Title:</b>	<b>Consideration Amendment to City Ordinance Chapter 2, Section 2-61 pertaining to the Sale of City Property</b>		

**Agenda Item Description (Background/History/Details):**

Currently, City Ordinance, Chapter 2, Section 2-61 restricts the sale of city property by either sealed bid or public outcry to the highest bidder for cash. An amendment is proposed to allow sale of city property through a contract vendor, like Enterprise. In many cases, use of a contract vendor may garner a higher price closer to fair market value over local sale options.

Additionally, another subsection is proposed that will allow the city staff to turn over wrecked or damaged insured city property to an insurance company upon receipt of payment.

**Workplan Goal Details:** Governance – Add additional options and clarity for the sale of city property.
