SUBJECT: Parking Restrictions on West Long Street

RECOMMENDATION:

Change the current parking restrictions regarding West Long Street located in Code of Ordinances 75.02 – Schedule II to read:

(A) No parking zones are established on the city streets are follows:

Street Location Times
Long Street, West Both sides from its intersection All

w/Graham to its intersection

w/Alexander Rd.

BACKGROUND:

The reconstruction of West Long Street will make east/west travel more attractive and viable to motorists as a major throughfare. Parking restrictions are currently in place for the 100 Blk of West long on both sides of the roadway along with restrictions on the north side of the roadway from Graham to Alexander. As the street is 25' feet wide any vehicles parked on either side of the street will impede traffic flow and possibly create a traffic hazard. By restricting parking on both sides of the street the roadway will remain clear and viable to traffic at all times. Parking restrictions will also create clear lines of site along both sides of the roadway and will reduce the chances of vehicle pedestrian interactions.
