RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends award of the 2024 Airport Apron Maintenance Project to Curtco, Inc. in the amount of \$58,075.00.

BACKGROUND:

On July 29, 2024, the City of Stephenville opened the single bid received for the above referenced project. A bid of \$58,075.00 was received from Curtco, Inc. of Center Point, Texas. Curtco, Inc. has experience in similar projects and a recommendation of award has been received from Eugene Calvert, P.E., the engineer of record.

PROJECT:

The project provides for crack sealing and full depth crack repairs of the flexible pavement on airport aprons near the hangars at the Stephenville Clark Regional Airport.

FISCAL IMPACT SUMMARY:

Project funding was appropriated at \$65,000 in the adopted FY23-24 budget leaving a positive balance of \$6,925.00. A TxDOT Routine Airport Maintenance Program (RAMP) Grant was secured by the Administrative Services Department and 90% of the project cost will be reimbursed through the grant.
