A & E Scope of Work:

Phase I – Prepare preliminary study including site plan, floor plan, exterior elevations and colored rendering.

Phase II – Prepare working drawings and bid documents consisting of, but not necessarily limited to, the following:

- 1. Site Plan
- 2. Floor Plan
- 3. Door, hardware, window, and room finish schedules
- 4. Door details
- 5. Cabinet elevations and details
- 6. Enlarged kitchen plan
- 7. Enlarged toilet plans, fixture schedules, and handicapped details
- 8. Wall sections
- 9. Building sections
- 10. Exterior elevations
- 11. Roof plans and design data
- 12. Foundation plan and details
- 13. HVAC plans and equipment schedule
- 14. Electrical power plan
- 15. Lighting plan and fixture schedules

- 16. Plumbing plan and fixture schedules
- 17. Specifications will be provided on drawings

Phase III - Bidding and Negotiation Stage

Assist client in obtaining bids for project and in negotiating contract(s) for construction.

Phase IV - Construction Stage

Provide on – site inspections as work progresses, reviewing pay requests and shop drawings. Assist the contractor and safeguarding the interest of the client.

Other items included in A & E Scope of Work:

- 1. Travel to and from project site.
- 2. 10 sets of documents for bidding and construction.
- 3. All engineering disciplines necessary to complete working drawings plus their normal duties of inspection during the construction stage. Engineering disciplines to be used on this project are defined as electrical, mechanical, and structural. Fees for these consultants will be the responsibility the Architect unless the scope of work varies substantially from this original agreement.
- Assist Owner in submitting documents to any state agency having jurisdiction on this project. Submittal and review fees will be the Owner's responsibility.

Fees:

For purposes of establishing A & E fees, the estimated cost of construction shall be \$1,200,000. Any difference in fees between the estimated cost and actual cost will be adjusted during Phase IV. The fee for the forementioned A & E services will be 8% of the cost of construction and shall be payable as scheduled below in percentage of completion:

Phase IPreliminary Stage - 15% of feePhase IIWorking Drawings - 70% of feePhase IIIBidding and Negotiation - 5% of feePhase IVConstruction Stage - 10% of fee
