WHEREAS, the Louisiana Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (LPDES) permit which authorized effluent discharge from the Highway 22 Sewage Treatment Facility mandates the Parish to institute a program directed towards pollution prevention in order to improve operating efficiency and extend the useful life of the treatment facility; and

WHEREAS, as part of Other Conditions, Section H. of LPDES permit LA0117676 (effective 11/1/16), the Parish Government must complete an annual Environmental Audit Report for the life of the permit, and a copy of the Environmental Audit Report is attached hereto.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES that the St. Tammany Parish Council acknowledges the receipt of the 2023 Municipal Water Pollution Prevention Environmental Audit Report for the Highway 22 Sewage Treatment Facility and its finding that future structural repairs will be needed to maintain compliance and the Bon Temps subdivision collection system and lift station need repair and improvement.

Pursuant to the permit authorizing effluent discharge, this Resolution is required to acknowledge the Environmental Audit and identify any compliance actions to be taken. No actions are necessary at this time to maintain compliance. Future structural and mechanical maintenance is needed to extend the useful life of the plant and continue future compliance.

Engineering design for rehabilitation and replacement of the Bon Temps sewer collection system and lift station is under contract. Engineering design for structural and mechanical repairs at the WWTP is also under contract
