

ST. TAMMANY PARISH DRAINAGE DISTRICT NO. 2 RESOLUTION 2024-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE ST. TAMMANY PARISH DRAINAGE DISTRICT NO. 2, Requesting Parish Council Approval of the Updated Drainage District Boundary Lines

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Drainage District No. 2 (hereinafter the "District" is a drainage district as provided for in Louisiana Revised Statute R.S. 38:1602 et seg and most particularly Louisiana Revised Statute 38:1674.15 and established pursuant to St. Tammany Parish Ordinances, Article 111, Section 115-138, of St. Tammany Ordinances

WHEREAS, the District has updated its drainage district boundary lines to more accurately reflect the areas that flow to the District Pump Station; and

WHEREAS, the District retained CSRS Inc., a professional engineering firm, in April 2024 to assist in identifying and confirming the areas contributing to the District Pump Station, ensuring that the updated boundary lines are precise and reflective of the current drainage system; and

WHEREAS, the District has held a public hearing on December 4, 2024, at the Slidell Administrative Complex located at 520 Old Spanish Trail, Slidell, LA 70458, in accordance with applicable laws, to receive input from the public on the proposed updated boundary lines; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was properly advertised in the St. Tammany Farmer Newspaper and posted at the Slidell Administrative Complex located at 520 Old Spanish Trail, Slidell, LA 70458; and

WHEREAS, the updated boundary lines were presented, and no substantive objections were raised during the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the St. Tammany Parish Drainage District No. 2 has accepted and adopted the updated boundary lines (Exhibit A), and now seeks formal approval from the St. Tammany Parish Council for the final adoption of these updated boundary lines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE ST. TAMMANY PARISH DRAINGE DISTRICT NO. 2 that:

Section 1: The Board requests formal approval from the St. Tammany Parish Government for the updated Drainage District Boundary Lines as presented by CSRS Inc., based on their analysis and confirmation of the areas that flow to the District Pump Station.

Section 2: The Board affirms that all legal requirements for public notification and participation have been met, including the holding of a public hearing and the publication of notice in the St. Tammany Farmer Newspaper and at the Slidell Administrative Complex.

Section 3: The Board respectfully requests that the St. Tammany Parish Government review and approve the updated boundary lines to ensure the continued effectiveness and efficiency of drainage services provided by the District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the St. Tammany Parish Council for their review and approval.
