ORDINANCE LEVYING DECREASED MILLAGE RATES FOR THE YEAR 2025 FOR DRAINAGE MAINTENANCE AND COUNCIL ON AGING/STARC.

WHEREAS, the Home Rule Charter for St. Tammany Parish Section 2-11 (3) requires an ordinance to levy taxes, assessments and charges.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS that in a public meeting held on <u>July 10</u>, <u>2025</u> which meeting was conducted in accordance with the Open Meetings Law and the additional requirements of Article VII, Section 23(C) of the Louisiana Constitution and R.S. 47:1705(B), that the Parish Council voted to **decrease** the millage rates on all taxable property shown on the official assessment roll for the year 2025, and when collected, the revenues from said taxes shall be used only for the specific purposes for which said taxes have been levied. Said millage rates are:

ADMINISTRATIVE COMMENT MILLAGE ORDINANCE – JUNE 2025

Drainage

The voters approved the levy of 1.69 mills for Drainage, with an authorized levy period from 2021-2030, at the March 20, 2021 election. The Drainage millage is for the purpose of improving, maintaining and constructing, bulk heading and bridging drainage ways, drainage ditches, drainage channels, and drainage canals within the Parish and related non-capital expenditures.

The millage for Drainage is proposed to be decreased from 1.56 mills to 1.46 mills to account for revenue collected over the 5% growth for fiscal year 2024 in Drainage Maintenance and Animal Services. Drainage Maintenance revenue increased by 11.16% in 2024. This should have been 5% (for growth) which translates into \$64,445.67 for 2024. Animal Service revenue increased by 6.79% in 2024. This should have been 5% (for growth) which translates into \$55,921.13.

In order to get to 'revenue neutral' in 2025 and address the overage in 2024, the rate will be reduced to 1.46.

Council on Aging/STARC

The voters approved the levy of 2.00 mills for Council on Aging/STARC, with an authorized levy period from 2019-2028, at the December 10, 2016 election. The millage is for the purpose of acquiring, construction, improving, maintaining and operating authorized activities, services, programs and/or facilities for Council on Aging and individuals with disABILITIES.

The millage for Drainage is proposed to be decreased from 1.69 mills to 1.60 mills to account for revenue collected over the 5% growth for fiscal year 2024. Council on Aging/STARC revenue increased by 11.14% in 2024. This should have been 5% (for growth) which translates into \$68,906.03.

In order to get to 'revenue neutral' in 2025 and address the overage in 2024, the rate will be reduced to 1.60.
