ADMINISTRATIVE COMMENT AMENDMENT NO. 3 - 2024 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS - JANUARY 2024

SECTION I: CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS - INFRASTRUCTURE (ROADS, BRIDGES, DRAINAGE, AND UTILITIES)

CAPITAL PROJECTS - 200-4640 - PARISHWIDE ROADS & DRAINAGE

Mandeville Bypass

Scope: The Mandeville Bypass is an east-west "by-pass" east of Mandeville that will provide more connectivity to the Parish by providing an east/west corridor connecting LA1088 and US190. The corridor is to provide relief and an alternate route for traffic now using LA1088, LA59, and portions of US190 through the City of Mandeville to reach US190 east of Mandeville with a project ADT (average daily traffic) count of approximately 13,000 through 2048. The two-lane roadway will exist within a 200-foot right-of-way with an approximate length of 18,500 feet or 3.5 miles, and include a 10-foot multi-use path.

Status: In January 2023, LADOTD approved the Intersection Control Evaluation (ICE) reports for the US190 and LA1088 intersections regarding Mandeville Bypass Rd. project. The approval letter from LADOTD required multiple geometric revisions for the two intersections. Since that approval, the consultant engineer has been working on plan re-designs for the two roundabouts to satisfy LADOTD comments.

Revised roundabout designs were submitted to LADOTD on 11/16/23. They responded requesting that the Parish submit several review sets to LADOTD for approval (30%, 60%, 90%, 100% preliminary, JPR, 60% final, 95% final, and 100% final). With this new information we now expect LADOTD permit approval in April of 2024.

The final right-of-way lines have been determined and we are proceeding forward with acquiring the additional parcels. For project expediency, the property acquisition consultant will focus on the connection to LA1088 first, as this may allow for clearing of the right-of-way to start mid-2024. All land acquisition activities are expected to be completed in mid-2024. Land acquisition is the controller of schedule going forward, particularly because more properties are affected due to the geometry changes at the intersections. Of the 19 original parcels, 17 have already been acquired. The roundabout re-design of LA1088 from a single lane roundabout to a multi-lane roundabout, as well as adding the dedicated right lane to the roundabout at US190 required an additional seven parcels to be acquired. To date, 65% of the parcels have been acquired. The Mandeville Bypass project is currently working toward final design plans and bid documents. Project is expected to be ready for bid concurrently with the completion of right-of-way acquisition.
