#### CAPITAL PROJECTS - 200-4640 - PARISHWIDE ROADS & DRAINAGE

### LA1077 Corridor Traffic Analysis

Scope: St. Tammany Parish is working with the LADOTD and the New Orleans Regional Planning Commission to evaluate the LA1077 corridor to determine how to make it safer and increase the capacity for vehicular traffic.

Status: Currently, the Parish is preparing to solicte vendors for qualifications in order to contract for the corridor traffic evaluation. This is the next step required by DOTD and RPC in identifying any issues. This amendment request is to add funding that the State has provided for the study via FP&C.

#### LA1088 Economic Development District Infrastructure

Scope: The Council is budgeting seven million dollars (\$7,000,000.00) from Sales Tax District 3 funds for purposes of reserving said funds for use to provide for infrastructure necessary for the development of a major economic development project(s) with the Hwy 1088 Economic Development District. The funds will be utilized for roads and drainage projects to be identified. Upon identifying specific roads and drainage projects, a budget amendment will be brought forward to obligate a certain amount from the seven million dollars (\$7,000,000.00) prior to encumbering the funds.

Status: At this time, the anticipated first phase of project(s) to be located within the Hwy 1088 Economic Development District will be within the area designated as Gulf South Commerce Park. Road and Drainage infrastructure associated with Phase 1 is estimated to be approximately four million two hundred thousand dollars (\$4,200,000.00)(\$1,000,000.00 for drainage and \$3,200,000,00 for roads). Additional road and drainage improvements are needed in order to provide infrastructure ahead of future build out. Regional drainage infrastructure for full build out of the Gulf South Commerce Park is estimated to exceed four million dollars (\$4,000,000.00). Additional infrastructure estimates are being finalized and will be available in the near term.
