WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish has submitted an application for funding under the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Infrastructure Program; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing & Urban Development regulations require that St. Tammany Parish certify that these activities for which CDBG funds are being requested are designed to alleviate existing conditions which pose a serious and immediate threat to the health or welfare of the community; which are of recent origin or which recently became urgent, and that the St. Tammany Parish is unable to commit local funding for the activity on its own, and that no other funds are available; and

The Louisiana Office of Community Development has classified the Alton, Ben Thomas and St. Joe Neighborhood water improvement projects as urgent need. These projects will include replacing a water storage tank and the rehabilitation of an existing water well in the Alton Neighborhood, connecting the Alton and St. Joe water systems together so that Alton can be used as a secondary water source in the event of a well failure, and connecting the Ben Thomas water system to a nearby water system to be used as a secondary water source in the event of a well failure.
