ADMINISTRATIVE COMMENTS:

On July 7th the Council at the request of several departments adopted new fee structures related to development charges. One such fee Sec. 2-709. - Zoning changes was updated from a tiered structure (year adopted 1998) to an updated tier fee structure. However, additional text within the section needs to be updated and clarified related to the distribution of the fees. The correction is as follows:

Sec. 2-709. - Zoning changes.

- (1) Existing developed single family residential:
 - a . Per acre \$50.00;
 - b. Maximum acreage fee \$1,250.00.
- (2) (1) Other All zoning changes:
 - a. Per acre for first 25 acres \$100.00;
 - b. Per acre for remaining acres \$10.00;
 - b. Maximum acreage fee \$5000.00;
 - <u>c.</u> Processing fee \$250.00 \$500.00;
 - <u>d.</u> Advertising fee \$75.00 \$150.00.
