WHEREAS, the State of Louisiana, Department of Natural Resources (“DNR”), has allocated funding towards supporting a Local Coastal Resources Management Program (“LCMP”; and

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government desires to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with DNR for funding benefitting an update and administration of a LCMP.

THE PARISH COUNCIL OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES: that St. Tammany Parish Government, through the Office of the Parish President, is hereby authorized to sign and/or execute a Cooperative Agreement with the State of Louisiana, Department of Natural Resources, regarding grant funding towards the Local Coastal Resources Management Program and to take all actions necessary, including entering into all agreements or negotiations in furtherance of the actions contemplated herein.
